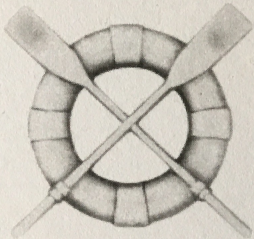
**Minutes** for May 2019 were approved.
